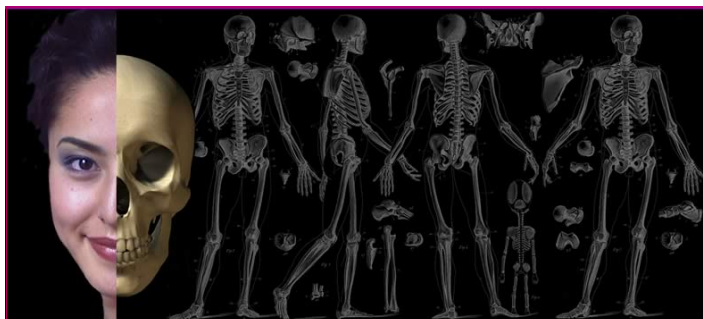


NEW Forensic Science Minor at Southern Illinois University Carbondale Starting Fall 2007



What is Forensic Science?

- Forensic Science is the application of scientific knowledge to the legal system.
- People who work in the field of Forensic Science are medical examiners, crime lab analysts, crime scene examiners, forensic anthropologists, and forensic biologists (to name just a few).
- This Forensic Science Minor is a new **interdisciplinary** program designed to **complement** a variety of Majors in forensics-related fields offered at SIUC
- This program will provide students with **critical knowledge** and **practical skills** for evaluating forensic evidence in a variety of research environments.
- Students must complete **15 hours** of courses to obtain the Forensic Science Minor.

What kind of classes are offered in the Forensic Science Minor?

- Students must complete **15 hours** of courses to obtain the Forensic Science Minor.
- There are **3 required** courses (9 hours):
Administration of Justice 201: Introduction to Criminal Justice
Anthropology 231: Forensic Anthropology
Chemistry 273: Introduction to Forensic Science
- There are a **wide variety of electives** to choose from in diverse departments across campus, including Allied Health, Administration of Justice, Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Philosophy, Plant Biology, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and Zoology.
